11th according to Mustaali branch, 840-81)

Abdul Allah al-Mahdi Billah
(873-934)

(11th Imam according to Nizari branch of Ismailis, 12th according to Mustaali branch, 881-934)
(founder/1st Shi'a Fatimid Caliph of Ifriqiya/north Africa centered on al-Qayrawan/Kairouan in modern day Tunisia, 909-34)

Abu Qasim Muhammad al-Qaim
(893-946)

(born Abd ar-Rahman in Syria; fled with father to Ifriqiya)
(2d Fatimid Caliph; 12th Imam according to Nizari branch of Ismailis, 13th according to Mustaali branch, 934-46)

Al Mansur (913-53)

(3rd Fatimid Caliph; 13th Imam according to Nizari branch of Ismailis, 14th according to Mustaali branch, 946-53)

Ma'ad Al Mu'izz li-Dinallah (932-75)

(4th Fatimid Caliph; 14th Imam according to Nizari branch of Ismailis, 15th according to Mustaali branch, 953-75)
(moved capital from Kairouan in Ifriqiya to al-Qahiratu/Cairo in Egypt, 969); (tolerant of Jews & Christians)

Abu I-Mansur Wizar al-Aziz (955-996)

(5th Fatimid Caliph; 15th Imam according to Nizari branch of Ismailis, 16th according to Mustaali branch, 975-96)
(conquered Palestine & Syria; created Mameluke Turkish slave army); (tolerant of Jews & Christians)

Sitt Al-Mulk
(970-1023)

Asma bint Umayr (sister of Al-Hakim)
(Regent to nephew Ali Az-Zahir, 1021-23)

Al-Hakim bi-Amr Allah (985-1021)
(6th Fatimid Caliph; 16th Imam according to Nizari branch of Ismailis,
17th according to Mustaali branch, 996-1021)

= Amina Ruqayyaa, cousin of husband
(daughter of Abdu l-Lah, son of Al-Mu'izz)

Ali az-Zahir
(1005-36)

(7th Fatimid Caliph; 17th Imam according to Nizari branch of Ismailis, 18th according to Mustaali branch, 1021-36)

Abu Tamim Ma'add al-Mustansir bi-Ilah (1029-94)

(8th Fatimid Caliph; 18th Imam according to Nizari branch of Ismailis, 19th according to Mustaali branch, 1036-94)
(Cairo and Fatimid empire came under control of the Mamelukes and Berbers)

Abu Mansur Nizar al-Mustafa li-Dinallah
(1045-97)

(deposed by Al-Afdal Shahanshah, 1066-1121, Armenian Mameluke who was ruling Vizier)
(19th Imam according to Nizari branch of Ismailis, 1095-97)

Al-Hadi
(1076-1136)

(born Cairo, Egypt; fled to Persia)
(20th Imam according to Nizari branch of Ismailis, 1097-1136)

Ahmad al-Musta'li
(1050s/60s?-1101)

(9th Fatimid Caliph & 20th Imam according to Mustaali branch, 1097-1101)
(puppet of Mamelukes); (Palestine lost to Christian Crusaders, 1099)

Al Amir bi'Ahka-mi l-Lah
(1096-1130)

(10th Fatimid Caliph & 21st Imam according to Mustaali branch, 1101-30)
(regained power from Mamelukes, 1121); (assassinated; no direct heir)

At Tayyid Abi l-Qasim (1126-)

(purported to be son of Al Amir)
(Last Imam according to Mustaali branch fo Ismailis; will return at end of world)

Al Hafiz (1090s/1100s-1149)
(cousin of Al Amir)

(11th Fatimid Caliph, 1130-49)

Al-Zafir (1020s-54)
(12th Fatimid Caliph, 1149-54)

Al-Faiz (1040s-60)
(13th Fatimid Caliph, 1154-60)

Al-Adid (1149-71)

(14th & Last Fatimid Caliph, 1160-71)
(allied with Christians of Palestine against Nur ad-Din of Syria)
succeeded by Saladin the Kurk, founder of Ayyubid dynasty)
