(grandson of Sir Richard Saltonstall, 1521-1608, Lord Mayor of London, 1597)
(West Riding, Yorkshire, England Justice & Lord of Manor of Ledsham)
(sold lands and emigrated to Massachusetts, 1630); (Massachusetts Bay Company gov council, 1630-31)
(returned to England, 1631); (Connecticut Colony investor, 1635); (English Ambassador to Holland, 1644)
(English High Court Judge for treason trials, 1649)
= Grace Kaye (1579-1625)

6 Others
Richard Saltonstall II
(1610-94)
(helped found Ipswich MA); (MA gov council, 1637; opposed council membership for life;
favored war with French Arcadia; opposed importation of black slaves); (returned to England, 1672)
= Muriell Gordon (1613-94)

(1639-1707)
(MA gov council, 1679-86, 1692); (resigned Salem Witch Trial judgeship, 1692)
= Elizabeth Ward (1647-1711)

(Governor of Connecticut, 1708-24)
