(born Lowville, Lewis co. NY); (moved to Michigan)
(California Gold Rush, 1849; miner)
(CA assembly, 1854-56, 1860-61; speaker, 1861); (Mayor of Caloma CA)
(moved to Idaho, 1863; mining/farming)
(ID Territory gov council, 1866-68, 1876-78); (Boise co. ID commisioner, 1872)
(Governor of Idaho Territory, 1885-89; persuaded President Cleveland
not to annex northern Idaho to Washington State)
(died Paraiso, Monterey co. CA)

(1824-at least 1870)
