Gen. Philip Henry Sheridan
(1831-88); (clerk/bookkeeper/soldier)
(born Albany NY); (moved to Somerset, Perry co. Ohio)
(US/Union Army, 1853-88; General, 1862-88)

1850

(Commanded Army of the Potomac Cavalry, 1864; Army of Shenandoah, 1864-65)
(Military Governor, 5th Reconstruction District in TX/LA, 1867)
(Commander, US Army Department of Missouri, 1867-77; directed war against Plains Indians)
(US Military Observer, Franco-Prussian War, 1870)
(Commanding General, US Army, with rank of General of the Army, 1883-88)

= Irene Rucker (1853-1926)
(daughter of US Army Quartermaster General
Brig. Gen. Danile H. Rucker of NJ, 1912-1910)
