(1827-86); (tobacco & vegetable farmer)
(born Buckingham co. VA); (moved to Lynchburg, Campbell co. VA, 1850)

= Emily M. Bruce (1839-at least 1880)
(daughter of George M. Bruce, 1809-, partner of
Gov. William "Extra Billy" Smith in founding first VA stagecoach)

(1869-at least 1920)
(founder, Meadow View dairy); (atheist after wife's death)

Carey Hezekiah Falwell
(1893-1948); (Dem)
(security agent/detective); (founder, C.H. Falwell Grocery; also general store & 17 service stations)

(founder, American Bus Lines, 1927); (bootlegger); (owned popular dance hall); (haunted by self-defense killing of younger brother Garland, 1931; became alcoholic)
(business enterprises damaged by Great Depression, then WWII rationing)
