Rev. William Franklin "Billy" Graham III
(1918-); (preacher/author)

(born Charlotte, Mecklenburg co. NC); (born-again Christian convert, 1934); (became evangelical Southern Baptist preacher)
(president, Northwest College of St. Paul, Minnesota, 1948-52); (gained fame with Los Angeles, California revival, 1949)
(formed Billy Graham Evangelical Association, 1950); (eventually preached in person, on radio and TV to 2.2 billion people)
(spiritual advisor to U.S. Presidents Truman, Eisenhower, Johnson, Nixon, Ford, Carter, Reagan, Bush I, Clinton, & Bush II)
(opponent of segregation)
