Georgia); (freed after Civil War); (moved to Henry co. GA) = Delia Lindsey (1875-1924) (father James Long a black slave used to breed slaves) 10 Others Rev. Martin Luther King I (1899-1984)1900 (born Michael King in Stockbridge GA; changed name about 1921); (succeeded father-in-law as minister of Ebenezer Baptist Church in Atlanta, Fulton co. GA) = Alberta Christine Williams (1904-74) (father Rev. Adam Daniel Williams, 1863-1931, pastor of Evenezer Baptist Church & first NAACP leader in Georgia) 2 Others Rev. Martin Luther King II (1929-68)(born Atlanta, Fulton co. GA); (Civil Rights leader/author/orator) (moved to Montgomery AL, 1954, then back to Atlanta GA) 1950 (helped found Southern Christian Leadership Conference, 1957) (gave "I Have A Dream" speech in Washington DC, August 1963); (Nobel Peace Prize, 1964) (opposed US involvement in Vietnam War); (assassinated in Memphis, Tennessee, April 4, 1968) = Coretta Scott of AL (1927-2006) (founder, Martin Luther King Jr. Center for Nonviolent Social Change in Atlanta GA, 1969) 4 Children
