(1870-at least 1920)

(born Missouri); (moved to Minnesota); (farmer/cargo inspector for Northern Pacific RR/traveling salesman of weighing scales)

Warren Earl Burger
(1907-95)

(born near St. Paul, Ramsey co. MN); (life insurance salesman/lawyer/teacher)
(moved to Washington DC/Virginia)

(US Assistant Attorney General, Civil Division, US Department of Treasury, 1953-56)
(US Court of Appeals for District of Columbia, 1856-69)

(US Supreme Court Chief Justice, 1969-86; Senior Status, 1986-)
(opposed gay rights; supported death penalty; voted for abortion rights under Roe v Wade decision)
