(born Clio, Barbour co. AL); (WWII/USAF); (AL house, 1947-53); (AL judge, 1953-58)
(Governor of Alabama, 1963-67, 1971-72, 1972-79, 1983-87); (survived assassination attempt but both legs paralyzed, 1972)
(opponent of Civil Rights for African-Americans and desegregation of schools until 1979, then reversed policy)
