 (moved from Portsmouth, New Hampshire to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania)  
 = ????  
 (1710s/20s?-at least 1812)

Jonathan Bayard Smith  
 (1742-1812); (merchant)  
 (Philadelphia committee of safety, 1775-77)  
 (US Continental Congress, 1777-78; Signer Articles of Confederation)  
 (PA judge, 1778); (helped found what became University of Pennsylvania, 1779)  
 (Philadelphia PA alderman, 1792-94); (PA auditor general, 1794)

Samuel Harrison Smith  
 (1772-1845); (Rep)  
 (founded Daily National Intelligencer and Washington Advertiser newspapers

 (president, Washington DC branch of 2d Bank of the U.S.)
