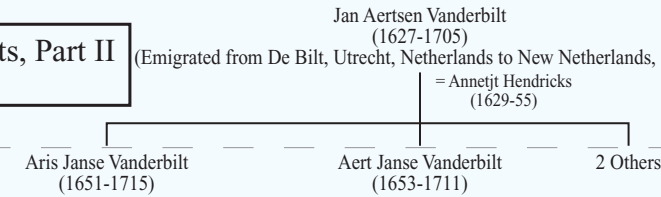

(Emigrated from De Bilt, Utrecht, Netherlands to New Netherlands, 1650)

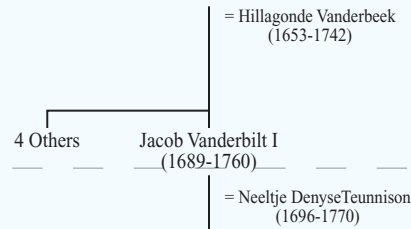
