(Irish ancestry; emigrated from Liverpool, England with parents to Toronto, Ontario, Canada)
(odd jobs/alcoholic/abandoned family, 1895)

= Elise Charlotte Printer (1873-1928)

(actress; A.K.A. Charlotte Hennessy, using mother's surname)
(toured U.S., 1900-; moved to Los Angeles, California, 1910)
(A.K.A. Charlotte Smith Pickford; managed daughter's career)

(1892-1979); (Rep); (actress/producer)

(actress, 1899-1933); (Emigrated from Toronto, Ontario, Canada with mother to U.S., 1900)

(moved to NYC; acted on Broadway twice, 1907-); (took stage name of Mary Pickford); (moved to Los Angeles, California, 1910)

(silent/talking film actress, 1909-33; for D.W. Griffith's Biograph Co., 1909-10, 1912; for Carl Laemmle's Independent Moving Picture Co., 1010-11;

for Universal, 1912; for Adolph Zukor's Famous Players, 1913-18; for First National, 1918-19); (known as America's Sweetheart)

(Mary Pickford Film Co.; movie producing, 1916-); (WWI/Liberty Bonds drive); (lived with 2d & 3rd husbands at Pickfair estate)

(co-founded/owner United Artists film distribution company, 1919-56, with Griffith, Charlie Chaplin, & Douglas Fairbanks I)

(founder, Motion Picture Relief Fund, 1919-21; to assist unemployed/disabled/retired actors); (friend of Calvin Coolidge)

(Academy Award for Coquette, 1929; Lifetime Academy Award, 1976)
