(born Brooklyn, Kings co. NY); (moved to Rahway, Union co. New Jersey)

(professor at University of California Berkeley, 1960-62, then Smithsonian Astrophysics Observatory at Cambridge, Massachusetts, 1962-6)

(professor, Cornell University, 1968-; director of Laboratory of Planetary Studies)

(Pulitzer Prize, 1978, for General Non-Fiction for Contact, later made into a feature film, 1997); (TV series Cosmos; A Personal Voyage, 1980)

(popularizer of astronomy & science through appearances on Johnny Carson's Tonight Show & other media)
