(1696-1751/56); (bricklayer)
(NYC common council from the Bower, 1718-43)
= Hillegond Webber of NYC
(1674-1728)

11 Others — Cpt. Mangle Minthorne
(1740-1824); (cooper/shop keeper/merchant/farmer)
(Tory/Loyalist sympathies; violated policy of not selling British imported tea; dismissed from position in NY militia)
(fled NYC at the British invasion, 1776, but returned 1778); (NY common council, 1792-1800; alderman, 1800-05, 1808)
