his drinking and poker playing)

(1868-1967); (Dem)
(born Red River co. TX); (owner, Garner Abstract and Land Company)
(TX judge, 1893-97); (TX house, 1898-1902)
(US House, 1903-33; speaker, 1931-33)
(US Vice President, 1933-41)
