(born Brooklyn, Kings co. NY); (clerk/teacher/writer/suffragette) (studied languages in Germany, 1906-8, then Oxford, England, 1908-)

— (co-founder with Alice Stokes Paul of Congressional Union For Women's Suffrage, 1913) — (co-founder with Alice Stokes Paul of National Woman's Party, 1916-20) (opposed US entry into WWI; picketed the White House, 1917; arrested, an "Iron-Jawed Angel"
